

Prof. V. Salvatore is full professor of European Union Law at the University of Insubria, Department of Economics. He was Head of the Legal Service of the European Medicines Agency (from 2005 until 2011 also Data Protection Officer). He teaches to both undergraduate and postgraduate students: Institution of European Union Law, International Trade Law. He has been Member of the board of the PHD programme in Methods and Models for Economic Decisions at the University of Insubria, Department of Economics from 2015 to 2018. He is member of the editorial board of European Pharmaceutical Law Review (since 2017) and referee of several legal journals. Over the last 10 years he has spoken in more than 40 international conferences or workshops organised by Universities or the European Parliament and held in Italy, United Kingdom, Belgium, Spain, Portugal, France, Brazil, United States, Poland, on numerous research topics related to institutional and substantial aspects of EU law, mainly focusing on EU pharmaceutical law, data protection and fundamental rights. Since 2016 he is in the list of experts of the European Parliament Research Service (EPRS), delivering reports on selected topics at the Comparative Law Forum.

Since 2011, he has published 6 monographs and edited 2 books, in addition to more than 30 articles/essays published in renowned international and Italian Law Journals.

His areas of research are EU Institutional law, European pharmaceutical and medical device law, European Union agencies, Health law, Privacy and data protection, Transparency and Access to documents, Protection of fundamental rights in the EU, EU staff regulations, Judicial remedies and litigation proceedings before the Court of Justice of the European Union, Division of powers between EU and member States, Public procurement.
